



## Abalo Nunyakpe, M.D.

As the Medical Director at Omni Family Medical Clinic, S.C. Dr. Abalo Nunyakpe oversees all clinical functions of the medical practice. Dr. Nunyakpe began his career working for Family Health Plan (now owned by Aurora) on Milwaukee's south side in 1994. He later became the Assistant Medical Director at Medpoint Family Care Center, before opening his own private practice, Omni Family Medical Clinic, S.C., in 2001.

Dr. Nunyakpe was born in Lome, Togo in West Africa. He studied medicine in China where he received his medical degree from the Beijing Medical University. While in China, he also studied Chinese medicine and acupuncture, and taught for the Northern School of Chinese Medicine in Minneapolis, Minnesota from 1988 to 1991. He completed his family practice residency at the University of North Dakota in Grand Forks, North Dakota in 1994.

Dr. Nunyakpe is board certified in family medicine. He practices under the full scope of family medicine, as well as obstetrics and gynecology, and pain management. He is a clinical associate professor for the department of physician assistant studies at Marquette University, and has volunteered as a medical doctor for the Clinics of Mawuena in West Africa, and the Cambodian Refugee Camps in Thailand. He is a member of the Wisconsin Medical Society, Cream City Medical Society, American Medical Association, Alliance Francaise de Milwaukee, and the American Academy of Family Practice Physicians.
